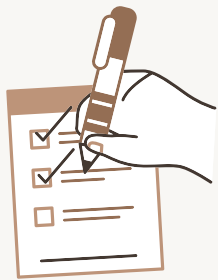


Help!

Try this...



1. Use **OneSearch** (library.hollins.edu)

2. Ask at the checkout desk to see if the item is on **reserve**

3. **Talk to your professor.** Ask...

- Will an older edition work?
- Can they put a personal copy of the text on reserve with the library?
- Can they scan chapters of the book and post them on Moodle?
(Copyright restricts faculty from scanning too much of one book.)

4. Look for **used copies** on ThriftBooks, Chegg, Amazon, Z-Library, or Anna's Library

5. Reach out to a **librarian** via chat, by email, or by contacting library@hollins.edu

6. Look at the **Emergency Funds** section of the Student Handbook, which includes the Elizabeth Lee Patterson Horizon Fund and the Student Outreach & Support (SOS) Fund.



7. **If all else fails:** contact the Dean of Students, Moody office 2nd floor.
